

- The exemption card relating to the exemption from payment of tolls on the M8 Rathcormac/Fermoy Bypass is issued in compliance with the M8 Rathcormac/Fermoy Bypass Bye-Laws which came into operation in September 2006. The card relates solely to the category of <u>Disabled Driver</u> of Specially Adapted Vehicles.
- 2. The card is issued by Direct Route (Fermoy) Ltd. and must be tendered to a toll collector at a manned toll booth on each occasion of use. The toll collector is required to register the details contained on the exemption card. The appropriate toll will be levied if a valid exemption card is not presented.
- 3. The exemption card is valid for 2 years (from date of issue). Sufficient time should be allowed for renewal of the card in advance of the expiry date stated on the card.
- 4. The card can only be used by the specified holder whilst driving the specially adapted vehicle the details of which are as specified on the application form. Before issuing a card, Direct Route (Fermoy) Ltd. may require to inspect the vehicle to confirm eligibility.
- 5. The card is not valid for vehicles used for the purposes of conveyance of goods or persons for hire or reward.
- 6. Notwithstanding eligibility for the exemption, toll free passage will not be allowed if the card holder is not in possession of the card at time of travel.
- 7. Changes in circumstances regarding the type of specially adapted vehicle or its registration details or any changes in disability entitlements must be notified to Direct Route (Fermoy) Ltd.
- 8. Loss of identity card must be reported to Direct Route (Fermoy) Ltd. as soon as possible
- 9. Cards are not transferable and must be kept and used in accordance with these terms and conditions.
- 10. Any authorised officer of Direct Route (Fermoy) Ltd. has the right, upon production if necessary of his/her identity, to be satisfied that the card in use has been issued to an eligible individual and that the person is driving the vehicle.
- 11. Abuse of the terms and conditions of use of the card could constitute an offence under the Roads Act 1993 and lead to its withdrawal.
